Our 24-week pre-apprentice programs offer prospective students free, hands-on training and paid, on-the-job experience to help secure an apprenticeship as a general machinist or industrial millwright mechanic.

Sheridan also offers full- and part-time apprenticeship training programs for electricians, general machinists, industrial electricians, industrial mechanic millwrights, plumbers and tool and die makers. Students can put classroom-based theory into practice on machinery and equipment similar to what they'll use in the workplace.

At Sheridan's Magna Skilled Trades Centre – a state-of-the-art facility in Brampton, Ontario – the pathway to entering a skilled trade is more accessible than ever.
